

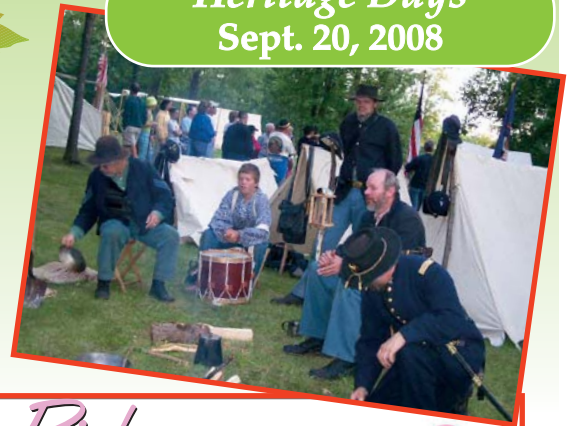

Waldenwoods History Notes

In 1879, J.B. Crouse left Hartland at the age of 37 and moved to Highland, MI to start the Highland Pickle and Vinegar Company with H.A. Tremaine (the start of a 42 year partnership). My guess is they had word that the railroad was coming through Highland because they bought a big chunk of land adjacent to where the rail came in just a couple years later. The factory prospered immensely and was sold when JB and HA started the Crouse-Tremaine Carbon Company in Cleveland in 1893.
