## David's Report

**Spring Thaw Conditions -Attention Campers -** When you see the sign posted at the Entrance Gate "Spring Thaw Conditions in Effect", please adhere to the following:

1. Keep your RV unit on boards if at all possible.
2. Park your car or truck just off the road next to your campsite.
3. Pull on and off campsites only after you have checked the site for thawing conditions.
4. If sites are extremely wet, delay pulling on or off site for a day.
5. Have our staff move your unit off site the day after you leave if conditions permit.

We cannot be responsible for units or vehicles that become stuck. This is one of the reasons we do not move units until May 1st. Due to the spring thaw conditions certain sites and even entire lanes may be closed until May 1st.

**"Lake Ice Unsafe"** - When you see this sign at the Entrance Gate, NEVER go out on the Lake. As the lake thaws, it becomes VERY unstable and unpredictable. Even if it appears safe, IT ISN'T.

**Dogs - Attention all Dog owners,** if you would like to bring your dog out camping with you this

summer, complete or update your dog registration and pick up your sticker. **We must have this on file before we can allow your pet in the park.**

**Electric Vehicles-** As was the case last year, anyone wishing to bring an electric vehicle (car, golf cart or scooter) into the resort will be asked to complete an annual agreement/registration form and display the appropriate sticker (fee applies). We would like to continue to offer this benefit for our members who have a hard time getting around the resort

**Pontoon Boat Slips -** Beginning April 1st we will be accepting reservations for our pontoon boat slips. There are a limited number of spaces and reservations will be taken on a first come, first serve basis. Specific slip numbers will be given away in a drawing after we have reached our maximum capacity.
