JANUARY... Activities will be walking dogs at Animal Crackers Dog Kennel and Boarding in Hartland. These amazing pets need some love at this time!



Despite the challenges of 2020, we are continuing to plow ahead with the campground and cottage

area expansion. I know it's tempting, especially for the little ones, but please steer clear of the construction zones. The first to get completed will be about 70 new full-hookup sites on Ginkgo Lane and the Kite field. As part of this process, we've also greatly improved the drainage in F row and the storage area. A new kite field is being built just north of the existing kite field so we'll still have a nice open space area. The emergency entrance will also be completed about that time. After that, we'll start building the expanded cottage area which should hold an additional 20 cottage sites with three cottages arriving this summer. Finally, we'll come back and relocate the horseshoe pits to the water front and extend E and F row to add 15 more full-hookup sites there too. So that's the plan and we hope we can get this done quickly and start enjoying the new space soon! Thanks for your patience and support!
