

We even rebuilt some sites up from scratch to improve the drainage. Yea, you'll still get wet when it rains but the infrastructure we have in place will drain it away more quickly. We also did some more site electrical improvements and add 8 new Wi-Fi towers. Security in the resort has never been better now that we've replaced both entrance and exit gate systems, converted to exit gate systems, converted to proximity cards only, and replaced the software behind it all. And yes, there are about 50 new campsites and the cottage area is almost complete. We hope you like and enjoy the improvements!
